**Miscellaneous:**

Both track trucks are owned outright by the club.

Time to do grant paperwork for the State of Maine.

Wide track – do we really need? We have two track trucks with full set up. Do we need something small to groom Club trail?

Seat is ready for pick up from D&L Upholstery

Trail work Sun. 10/11 9:00 am. Work Jellerson Road towards exit to Waterhouse/Route 5/202 – side clearing.

Corey's Trail – Crooked bridge – Brian/Tom/Anthony walked it. Large boulders – need mini excavator to move smaller boulders. Options discussed:

- Rent excavator at \$1,200/week
- Drill holes into rock add a rock breaking solution, will need compressor – then move smaller boulders. Will need fill also. May need to find another trail. May be able to use this trail for one more winter.
- Hire Corey to move boulders with his equipment.
- Bucket loader with wood chips

Eagle Scout to help with trail work. Roger will talk to the group.

Club House Clean Up – weather permitting – 11/1, 9am-12pm. Roger will check w/Brad about tin trim.

V&V (liability) insurance due. Last year \$1,277.
