- Checking: \$2,490.38

## **TRAIL MASTER:**

- Need to replace bridge across from Route 111 and bottom of Hector's hill
- Need to move 4 trails: Grondon's pit, behind clubhouse, Cory's land, DS&G, and Esty's Trail
- We need to prioritize work and maintain our 30 mile trail.
- Town may be doing tree harvesting this summer as part of their forest management program. They may do some on our 15 acres.
- We have enough 3" boards to do Hector's bridge.

## **Other:**

- The group agreed to donate \$150.00 for a Lyman child to attend Bunganut Camp this summer. Marie will get check to the camp.
- Our property lease has been signed by the town and LSC President for another 5 years. The lease indicates we cannot store "parts vehicles" – nothing that is not in working order – on the property.
- Champagne Fuel wants to swap out our tank. They want to give us a 100 gal tank instead of the larger one we now have. After discussion Luke said he would give us a couple of the small tanks he has and we will pay for the fill ups.
- Club House Renovation – Roger has drawings. John Swett looked at property to place well (side of fire pit). He will charge us his cost for casing plus 100 gal of diesel fuel and we need to have him do it on his schedule. Shouldn't be more than \$1,000 without pump. We will need to check with Patty re: location. A motion was made, seconded and accepted to move forward with John Swett.
- Golf Scramble – Committee members (Tom, Anthony, Don, Celeste, Roger, Brad, Marie & Gregg) will meet at the clubhouse on May 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7pm to begin work on the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual LSC Golf Scramble.
